Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

Night Work Scheduled to Begin Feb. 22: Friars Road and Mission Center Road & Friars Road and Frazee Road

Starting on Sunday night, February 22, crews on the City of San Diego's Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline project will begin work during nighttime hours to install pipeline at the Friars Road and Mission Center Road intersection, and the Friars Road and Frazee Road intersection. Please see the additional details provided below for each portion of work.

Work at Friars Road and Mission Center Road

- Working hours are 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Beginning Sunday, February 22, at 9 p.m.
- Completed Friday, March 13 at 5 a.m. (No work Fri. 2/27 or Sat. 2/28)
- During working hours, (9 p.m. to 5 a.m.), traffic will be limited through the intersection and detours may be required, please follow all posted signage
- During non-working hours, the intersection will be fully open for traffic

Work at Friars Road and Frazee Road

- Working hours are 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Beginning Sunday, February 22, at 9 p.m.
- Completed Friday, February 27 at 5 a.m.
- The intersection will remain open for traffic during working hours and non-working hours

To ensure everyone's safety, all construction activity will be contained within the marked work zone. After the pipeline has been installed, crews will temporarily pave over the trench before moving to the next section. Throughout this work, crews will maintain the cleanliness of the work zone to minimize any dust leaving.
