**Subject: Update to Information Bulletin 180 – Hydrant Flow Data - Online Request Process**

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Effective Feb. 19, 2026, the City's Development Services Department (DSD) will require that hydrant flow data requests be submitted through its [online permitting portal](#). This will phase out the existing emailed form process and further DSD's commitment to streamlining these processes for customers.

To perform this service, each hydrant flow request will be charged the hourly fee of \$164.87 (current fee) starting Feb. 19, 2026.

Details on how to submit a hydrant flow request in the online portal can be found in [Information Bulletin 180](#).

Hydrant flow information is required when applying for fire sprinkler or standpipe permits requiring hydraulic calculations within the City's jurisdiction. The City of San Diego utilizes a computer model to track and display the flow and pressure of fire hydrants within the City of San Diego water district.

For any previously mailed in or emailed DS-160 forms postmarked before the Feb. 19 date, DSD will process them in accordance with current procedure.

As a reminder, it is the contractor's responsibility to confirm the available static pressure at the system point of connection prior to beginning design of the system(s) and to report any discrepancies to [DSDHydrantFlow@sandiego.gov](mailto:DSDHydrantFlow@sandiego.gov) as soon as possible.
