

## **CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Intermittent Nighttime Work at La Jolla Village Drive and Towne Centre Drive Intersection**

Beginning as early as Monday, March 2, the City of San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels' contractor will begin working during the nighttime at the La Jolla Village Drive and Towne Centre Drive intersection to complete pavement base repair work. Nighttime work will be scheduled intermittently in the coming months as preparation for final pavement resurfacing.

Nighttime work, when scheduled, will take place Monday through Friday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Initial nighttime work is expected to begin as early as March 2 and continue for approximately two weeks. Crews will return to the La Jolla Village Drive and Towne Centre Drive intersection to continue nighttime work at a later date. Additional notice will be provided when crews are scheduled to return.

The work will be completed using two traffic control configurations. The La Jolla Village Drive and Towne Centre Drive intersection will be closed to northbound and southbound traffic for both traffic control set-ups. The traffic controls shown on the maps included below will only be in place during the nighttime work hours and will be picked up from the intersection at the end of each shift.

For the first traffic control set-up, northbound traffic on Towne Centre Drive will be detoured to turn right onto eastbound La Jolla Village Drive, detoured left onto Judicial Drive and then left onto Eastgate Mall to return to Towne Centre Drive. Southbound traffic will be detoured to turn right onto westbound La Jolla Village Drive, detoured left onto Genesee Avenue and then left onto Nobel Drive to return to Towne Centre Drive.

For the second traffic control set-up, the northbound detour will remain the same. Southbound traffic on Towne Centre Drive will be detoured to turn right onto westbound Executive Drive, detoured left onto Executive Way and then left onto La Jolla Village Drive to return to Towne Centre Drive.

The City and project team are committed to completing construction as safely and efficiently as possible, and the University City community's patience and coordination are appreciated. Please note that construction schedules are subject to change at any time.

### **What to Expect:**

- Electronic message boards will be placed as advanced notification about the traffic control shift.
- Parking restrictions will be enforced; please avoid parking in areas with "no parking" signs. Vehicles in violation of these signs will be towed.
- 24/7 access for emergency vehicles, residences and businesses will be maintained.

- Please anticipate traffic delays and construction noise.
- For safety reasons, please follow all posted signs including detours for traffic.

**Why:** Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035 and significantly reduce treated discharges from the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant. Pure Water San Diego will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water and wastewater needs. San Diegans are getting dual value from this investment — reliable, sustainable drinking water and avoided wastewater costs. The Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.
