

SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND PAVING GREAT FUTURES FOR VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION SERVICES

This Second Amendment to the Agreement between the City of San Diego and Paving Great Futures for Violence Prevention and Intervention Services (Second Amendment) is made and entered into by and between the City of San Diego (City) and Paving Great Futures, a Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation (Contractor), also referred to individually as “Party” and collectively as the “Parties.”

RECITALS

1. City and Contractor entered into an Agreement between the City of San Diego and Paving Great Futures for Violence Prevention and Intervention Services (Agreement) effective on July 12, 2024.
2. The Agreement may be amended by written agreement executed by duly authorized representatives of both Parties.
3. The Agreement was amended on May 14, 2025, to increase the compensation by \$201,324.45 to a new not to exceed amount of \$651,324.45 and to increase the amount of youth served by 50.
4. The Parties wish to amend the Agreement to increase the compensation by \$100,000 to a new not to exceed amount of \$751,324.45 and to increase the amount of youth served by 20
5. All initially capitalized terms herein shall have the same meaning as in the Agreement, unless otherwise specifically defined herein.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the above recitals and the mutual promises contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

TERMS


1. **Section 3.1** of the Agreement is revised in its entirety to read as follows:

Amount of Compensation. The City shall pay the Contractor for performance of all Services rendered in accordance with this Agreement and any amendments thereto, including reasonably related expenses, **in an amount not to exceed \$751,324.45.**

Exhibit A (Scope of Work) Section A. of the Agreement is revised in part to read as follows:

1. End repeat offenses among the **170 youth/young adults** enrolled in the Peacemaker Project (Program), including youth perpetrators and victims of violent crimes, youth referred by the County of San Diego Probation Department, and young adults re-entering the community post-incarceration.
2. This Second Amendment will be effective as of December 31, 2025 and approved by the City Attorney in accordance with Charter section 40.
3. All provisions of the Agreement not addressed in this Second Amendment remain in full force and effect.
