Opportunity for All San Diego Ballot Measure Committee by Sean Elo-Rivera, Yes on B and C

I. Introduction

This Audit Report contains information pertaining to the audit of the committee, Opportunity for All San Diego Ballot Measure Committee by Sean Elo-Rivera, Yes on B and C, Identification Number 1445295 (“the Committee”) for the period from August 16, 2022, through April 3, 2023. The Committee was selected for audit by a designee of the City Clerk in a random drawing conducted at a public meeting of the Ethics Commission held on September 14, 2023. The audit was conducted to determine whether the Committee materially complied with the requirements and prohibitions imposed by the City of San Diego’s Election Campaign Control Ordinance (San Diego Municipal Code Chapter 2, Article 7, Division 29).

During the period covered by the audit, the Committee reported total contributions of \$371,416.35 (inclusive of \$40,084.35 in non-monetary contributions) and total expenditures of \$283,951.63. Total cash contributions relative to total expenditures resulted in a \$6,619.63 differential that was reconciled by the Committee’s beginning and ending cash balance. **The audit revealed no material findings. The committee substantially complied with the disclosure and record-keeping provisions of the San Diego Election Campaign Control Ordinance.**

II. Committee Information

On August 12, 2022, the Committee filed a Statement of Organization with the San Diego City Clerk indicating that it qualified as a committee. The Committee was formed to support Measure B (Amends San Diego Municipal Code Section 66.0127 Related to Solid Waste Management Services) and Measure C (Removing 30-Foot Height Limit in Midway-Pacific Highway

Community Plan Area) in the November 8, 2022, general election. On April 3, 2023, the Committee filed a Statement of Organization stating that it was no longer supporting Measures B and C and indicating a change of its status to a general purpose city committee. The Committee's is treasurer is Stephanie D. Sanchez of Politica Campaign Treasury LLC.

III. Audit Authority

The Commission is mandated by San Diego Municipal Code section 26.0414 to audit campaign statements and other relevant documents to determine whether campaign committees comply with applicable requirements and prohibitions imposed by local law.

IV. Audit Scope and Procedures

This audit was performed in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards. The audit involved a thorough review of the Committee's records for the time period covered by the audit. This review was conducted to determine:

1. Compliance with all disclosure requirements, pertaining to contributions, expenditures, accrued expenditures, and loans, including itemization when required;
2. Compliance with applicable filing deadlines;
3. Compliance with restrictions on contributions, loans and expenditures;
4. Accuracy of total reported receipts, disbursements and cash balances as compared to bank records; and
5. Compliance with all record-keeping requirements.

V. Conclusion

Through the examination of the Committee's records and campaign disclosure statements, the Auditor verified that the Committee timely disclosed all contributions received and all expenditures made, and that the Committee maintained the necessary documentation regarding contributions and expenditures. **As a result, the Auditor determined that there were no material findings. The Committee substantially complied with the disclosure and record-keeping provisions of the San Diego Election Campaign Control Ordinance.**
