My community service includes championing traffic and e-bike safety initiatives, supporting pedestrian improvements, helping establish the Canon Street Pocket Park, and volunteering with the Rady Children's Hospital Auxiliary helping raise funds for families facing cancer.

I am a proud Indigenous woman, spouse of a disabled Navy combat veteran, and survivor of child marriage. I know what it means to serve and sacrifice and work with women across California to strengthen laws protecting children.
