**Councilmember Campillo Concludes Series of Annual Community Town Halls Across District 7**

**SAN DIEGO** — This week, San Diego City Councilmember Raul Campillo completed his annual series of Town Hall events throughout District 7. The Councilmember connected with residents in Navajo, Tierrasanta, Linda Vista, Mission Valley, and Serra Mesa in lieu of a traditional State of the District speech.

“To put it simply, my job is being responsive to the needs, wants, and concerns of each and every one of my constituents,” said Councilmember Raul Campillo. “The most effective way I have found to do that well is to meet people where they are and encourage open and honest discussion about what they care about most.”

All-in-all, this year’s series of Town Halls encouraged participation from 265 community members, asking a multitude of questions about everything from porta-potties to crosswalks. The Councilmember shared updates on:

- Recommending \$100,000 in funding for local non-profits,
- Completing infrastructure projects including paving 132 roads in the district, and
- Continuing his efforts to push for increased transparency and accountability at City Hall.

“Thank you for this evening's meeting. [It was] very informational and encouraging,” said Navajo resident D. Godwin. “Thank you for hearing your constituents and standing up for fairness and common sense on our behalf.”

“Thank you for holding the Town Hall in Tierrasanta,” said P. Huff. “I appreciate your integrity, your humor, your amazing staff, and that you have a moral compass.”

“Please pass along my appreciation to Councilmember Campillo and his staff for taking the time to hold the Town Hall meeting yesterday in Serra Mesa,” said J. Silcox. “He is a reminder of what we used to expect from our elected officials; someone who represents US! Thank you for continuing to fight the good fight.”

Since being elected, Councilmember Campillo has hosted nearly 60 Town Halls and community meetings in his district. In addition to the annual Town Hall series, Councilmember Campillo hosts Community Coffee throughout the District every other month. The 2026 Coffee with Campillo events will resume on April 25.
