Suspicious Death Investigation in Redwood Village

On March 19, 2026, at approximately 4:03 p.m., San Diego Police officers and San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel responded to a 9-1-1 call at a residence in the 3800 block of Loma Alta Drive in the Redwood Village Neighborhood. The caller reported discovering her ex-husband in the home unresponsive, not breathing, and with a significant amount of blood on and around him.

Paramedics and officers arrived within minutes and assessed the victim, a 46-year-old Hispanic male, for signs of life. He was pronounced deceased at the scene shortly thereafter.

Given the circumstances, and in an abundance of caution, detectives from the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit responded and have assumed responsibility for the investigation. At this stage, the cause and manner of death remain undetermined. Investigators are working in coordination with the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office to determine those details.
