## **Suspicious Death Investigation in Redwood Village Determined Not a Homicide**

**SAN DIEGO** - On March 19, 2026, at approximately 4:03 p.m., San Diego Police officers and San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel responded to a 9-1-1 call at a residence in the 3800 block of Loma Alta Drive in the Redwood Village Neighborhood. The caller reported discovering her ex-husband unresponsive, not breathing, and with a significant amount of blood on and around him, inside the home.

Paramedics and officers arrived within minutes and assessed the victim, a 46-year-old Hispanic male, for signs of life. He was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Given the circumstances, and in an abundance of caution, detectives from the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit responded and assumed responsibility for the investigation.

After a thorough investigation, it was determined his death was not a homicide. Therefore, his name will not be released.
