Man Killed in Barrio Logan Stabbing

San Diego – A man was stabbed in Barrio Logan late Friday night and later died.

On March 27, 2026, at about 11:13 p.m. San Diego Police Communications received multiple reports of a man stabbed in the south alley of 1600 Logan Avenue. As officers arrived, they observed the victim, described as a 28-year-old male of Somali decent, collapse to the ground. A citizen, the responding officers, and medics all provided medical aid at the scene. The man was transported to a local hospital, but unfortunately, he did not survive his injuries. The victim is not being identified until his family is notified of his death.

The Homicide Unit responded and will be handling the investigation. Detectives will be in the area throughout the day collecting evidence and canvassing for witnesses. Thus far, investigators have determined the victim was surrounded by a group of three Hispanic men, a Hispanic female, and then attacked by some in the group.

Officers detained a male and a female shortly after the stabbing, but they have since been released as detectives continue their investigation.
