(Process 3) Conditional Use Permit to allow the sale of beer, wine and distilled spirits for off-premises consumption at an existing convenience store and gas station that currently sells beer and wine, contingent upon the issuance of a license from the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. The 4.88-acre site is located at 13985 Torrey Del Mar Drive in the CN-1-2 (Commercial-Neighborhood) zone, the Airport Influence Area (MCAS Miramar - Review Area 2), the Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (MCAS Miramar), and a Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone within the Torrey Highlands Community Plan.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA State Guidelines, Section 15061(b)(3), Common Sense Exemption, and 15301, Existing Facilities of the California Environmental Quality Act.

ITEM 2: 3245 EL CAJON BOULEVARD – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1132060

Plan Area: Mid-City (City Heights) Communities

A Conditional Use Permit to allow the sale of beer and wine (contingent upon the issuance of a license from the State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control) at

a 22,698-square-foot grocery store. The 1.62-acre project site is located at 3245 El Cajon Boulevard in the CUPD-CU-2-4 (Central Urbanized Planned District – Central Urbanized) zone, a Sustainable Development Area, the Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (Review Area 2 for San Diego International Airport [SDIA]), the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Part 77 Noticing Area for SDIA, the Transit Area Overlay Zone, a Transit Priority Area, and a Parking Standards Transit Priority Area within the Mid-City (City Heights) Communities Plan.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3) (Common Sense Exemption) and Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

ITEM 3: AT&T SOUTH TORREY PINES – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1107460

Plan Area: La Jolla

(Process 3) Conditional Use Permit for the modification of an existing AT&T Wireless Communication Facility (WCF). The WCF is on a 30-foot traffic light standard with two (2) existing panel antennas with antenna skirts mounted at the top of the standard. The 54-square-foot above-ground equipment area consists of four (4) radios, four (4) cabinets, and a telco cabinet to be painted brown to match the adjacent environment. Landscaping, ground cover, and an associated irrigation system will be installed to increase the integration of the existing above-ground equipment. There are no modifications to the existing WCF equipment, other than to add the antenna skirts and paint the equipment brown. The WCF is located within the public right-of-way at 9170 1/3 North Torrey Pines Road, on the northwest corner of Expedition Way and North Torrey Pines Road, adjacent to the RS-1-7 (Residential Single Unit) zone of the La Jolla Community Plan.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN HEARING OFFICER HEARINGS

TO SPEAK TO A PARTICULAR ITEM DURING PUBLIC COMMENT:

In Person for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment: Please fill out a speaker slip located at the entrance to the meeting. Indicate the item you wish to speak on as well as other requested information. Then submit it to City staff.

Via Virtual Platform for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment: When the Hearing Officer introduces the item (or indicates it is time for Non-Agenda Public Comment), raise your hand by either tapping the “Raise Your Hand” button on your computer, tablet, or Smartphone, or by dialing *9 on your phone. You will be taken in the order in which you raised your hand. You may only speak once on a particular item. When the Hearing Officer indicates it is your turn to speak, unmute your phone by tapping the unmute button on your computer, tablet or Smartphone, or dial *6 on your phone.

Please Note: Members of the public who wish to provide virtual testimony must enter the virtual queue by raising their hand before the queue closes. The queue will close when the last virtual speaker finishes speaking or five minutes after in-person testimony ends, whichever happens first. *Those participating virtually may NOT cede time to others participating in person or virtually.*

HOW TO PROVIDE WRITTEN COMMENTS:

For Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment: Submit using the [webform](#), indicating the comment type and item number (if relevant). Comments must be received by the business day prior for it to be distributed to the Hearing Officer. All webform comments are limited to 500 words but may include attachments. Materials submitted via U.S. Mail must be received the business day prior for it to be distributed to the Hearing Officer.

Late-Arriving Materials:

Pursuant to the Brown Act, California Government Code Section 54957.5(b), late-arriving documents related to the Hearing Officer meeting agenda items which are distributed to the legislative body prior to and during the meeting are available for public review at the Development Services Department Building, 7650 Mission Valley Road, 1st Floor, San Diego, CA 92108.
