- **Call to Order:** The Meeting was brought to order at 11:34 AM by Jeff Sallen, Chair of the Kearny Mesa Planning Group via ZOOM.
- **Meeting Minutes:** The Meeting Minutes from January 21, 2026, were shared with all participants. A vote was held and approved 10-0-1.
