NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: 2026 WCC Cross Country Championship

LOCATION: Tecolote Shores South, Mission Bay, San Diego, CA 92109

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Approval of a Park Use Permit (PUP) for the 2026 WCC Cross Country Championship which will take place at Tecolote Shores South on October 30, 2026. The 2026 WCC Cross Country Championship would include the temporary use of canopies, portable toilets, recycling containers, generators, and sound amplification. Noise associated with the event activities and set-up/dismantling would occur starting on October 29, 2026. Set-up would take place from 8:00 am to 11:00 am on October 29th, the event would occur from 7:00 am to 12:00 pm on October 30th, and clean-up would occur from 12:00 pm to 1:30 pm on October 30th. Approximately 400-450 attendees are anticipated during the course of this event.

There would be no street or parking closures associated with this event.

ENTITY CONSIDERING PROJECT APPROVAL: City of San Diego

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15311(c) (Accessory Structures).

ENTITY MAKING ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: City of San Diego Mayor-Appointed Designee.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use; and Section 15311(c) (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to (appurtenant to) existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including but not limited to: placement of seasonal or temporary use items such as lifeguard towers, mobile food units, portable restrooms, or similar items in generally the same locations from time to time in publicly owned parks, stadiums, or other facilities designed for public use. The exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the

environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked before or on the final date of the appeal.
