- a. **Action Item 1 (6:15-6:25):** Discuss and potentially vote on potential actions regarding Park Blvd. traffic calming between Upas and Robinson. Kevin Carroll reached out and engaged the city traffic engineering department on proposed solutions for this section of Park Boulevard. Could consider writing a letter in support of traffic calming there.
- b. **Action Item 2 (6:25-6:35):** Discuss and potentially vote on possible actions regarding the 30th & Upas intersection. Multiple serious injury accidents have occurred here, including former NPPC member Liz Saba. Could ask the city for a comprehensive traffic engineering study to address these longstanding issues.
- c. **Informational Item 1 (6:35-6:45):** Discuss Adams & Alabama intersection by Trolley Barn Park. This intersection has weird geometry and is very wide, making it harder for people to cross to access Trolley Barn Park. Discuss what traffic calming (i.e. roundabout, curb extensions, stop sign, etc.) may be warranted here.
- d. **Informational Item 2 (6:45-6:55):** Discuss concerns raised about parking in the 3700 block of 30th St. A Traffic Service Request was filed with the city by Whips N Furs Costume Shop.
