Adolfo noted that we put money into the budget for FY 27 for fencing, he spoke with Jerry and is trying to get the fencing completed this Fiscal Year, along with extending the baseball field lines to 90 FT at Cabrillo Park.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- **San Diego Parks Foundation** – Martha was absent for this meeting, but it was noted that during this last quarter 40 trees were planted at Liberty Station and that the goal is to plant a total of 68 trees.
- **Point Loma/Cabrillo Tennis Club**- None
- **Point Loma Summer Concerts**- Everything is set to go for the Point Loma Summer Concert Series. Dates have already been discussed with Point Loma Little League. There will be a final cut and watering of the lawn prior to the concert series kicking-off.

- **Point Loma Little League** – Mr. Wiens shared that registration has finished and that the league will be kicking-off in a couple of weeks. There is a record turn out this year with 524 kids. Assessments are scheduled for this Saturday, make up assessments are scheduled for the following Saturday. Practices begin at the end of January. Opening day is Saturday, February 28, 2026, with the league ending July 07, 2026. The baseball diamond has been refreshed for this year. There are talks of extending the Cabrillo Joint Use infield by 10-15 feet and placing new anchors. It was noted that the irrigation heads are not on arc at Cabrillo Park currently.
