

## **Morena Conveyance South & Middle: Street Resurfacing**

Crews have successfully tied-in the pipeline that connects the Morena Middle segment to the Morena Northern Pipeline at Genesee Avenue & Appleton Street. Crews have now reached the northern end of the 6.9 miles of 48" force main and 30" brine pipeline to be installed by the project.

### **Final Paving & Restoration**

Beginning Monday, April 6, crews will begin paving at the intersection of Clairemont Drive & Lakehurst Ave., continuing along Clairemont Mesa Blvd., and proceeding to Genesee & Appleton St. Crews will first grind the roadway using heavy machinery, then place a new layer of asphalt once the grinding is complete. Work will take place during daytime from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. through Friday, April 10.

Increased noise and dust are expected throughout the duration of the grinding and paving work. For the safety of the public and workers, traffic control measures will be in place throughout the work zone. Residents and commuters are asked to follow all posted signage, exercise caution, and adhere to traffic control directions. On-street parking will be restricted for the duration of the work. Due to the scale of this week-long operation, delays in the area are anticipated. Please allow extra travel time and plan commutes accordingly.

**Why:** Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's later supply locally by 2035 and significantly reduce treated discharges from the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant. Pure Water San Diego will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water and wastewater needs. San Diegans are getting dual value from this investment — reliable, sustainable drinking water and avoided wastewater costs. The Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities.
