
Upcoming Weekend Work at Morena Blvd. and Milton St. Intersection

February 19, 2026

Construction for the Morena Conveyance South & Middle and Morena Conveyance Bike Lanes project is ongoing at the Morena Blvd. and Milton St. Intersection. Please be advised that weekend work is scheduled for Saturday, February 21, and Sunday, February 22, from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m. each day. The regular construction schedule continues to be Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., and the intersection continues to be closed 24 hours a day, seven days a week as crews install two new pipelines that will connect to the previously constructed pipeline on Milton St., marking a major milestone for the Pure Water Program.

A detour route is in place for the weekend work and throughout work taking place at Morena Blvd. And Milton St. intersection. This weekend's work aims to accelerate progress and reopen the intersection sooner, particularly after recent rainfall. For your safety, please follow all posted signage and plan extra time when traveling in the area to accommodate traffic delays.

During working hours, crews will operate large excavators to dig a trench where the shoring beams will be installed. All the work will take place behind the barricades of the work zone to ensure the safety of the public and crews while working. While crews are working, typical noise associated with construction may be heard. Throughout this work, crews will maintain the
