Man Arrested in Barrio Logan Stabbing

San Diego – A man was stabbed in Barrio Logan late Friday night and later died.

On March 27, 2026, at about 11:13 p.m. San Diego Police Communications received multiple reports of a man stabbed in the south alley of 1600 Logan Avenue. As officers arrived, they observed the victim, described as a 28-year-old male of Somalian decent, collapse to the ground. He is now identified as Abdifatah Hussein. Medical aid was provided at the scene, and he was transported to a local hospital, but unfortunately, Hussein did not survive his injuries.

The Homicide Unit responded and is conducting the investigation. According to preliminary information the victim was surrounded by a group of three Hispanic men and a Hispanic female and then attacked by some in the group. Officers detained a male and a female shortly after the stabbing, but they have since been released pending additional investigation. As detectives continued speaking to witnesses and reviewing security footage, they determined a black adult male was also part of the suspect group.

On March 29, 2026, investigators were working in the area of 100 South 17th Street, a short distance from the stabbing scene. They located 45-year-old Geoffrey Goodwell, who matched the description of the black male suspect involved in the attack. Goodwell was processed, interviewed, and later booked into county jail for the murder. Investigators are still actively working to identify the others in the suspect group.
