Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

Night Work Update

Crews on the City of San Diego's Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline project are making progress with night work at the Friars Road and Mission Center Road intersection. Please see the additional details provided below for each portion of work.

Night Work at Friars Road and Mission Center Road

- Working hours are 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning
- This phase is currently expected to be completed by Friday, March 6
- During working hours, (9 p.m. to 5 a.m.), traffic will be limited through the intersection and detours may be required, please follow all posted signage
- During non-working hours, the intersection will be fully open for traffic

Night Work at Friars Road and Frazee Road

- Work has been rescheduled, and is estimated to occur in April 2026
- Additional notifications will be sent once this work has been scheduled

To ensure everyone's safety, all construction activity will be contained within the marked work zone. After the pipeline has been installed, crews will temporarily pave over the trench before moving to the next section. Throughout this work, crews will maintain the cleanliness of the work zone to minimize any dust leaving.
