## Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

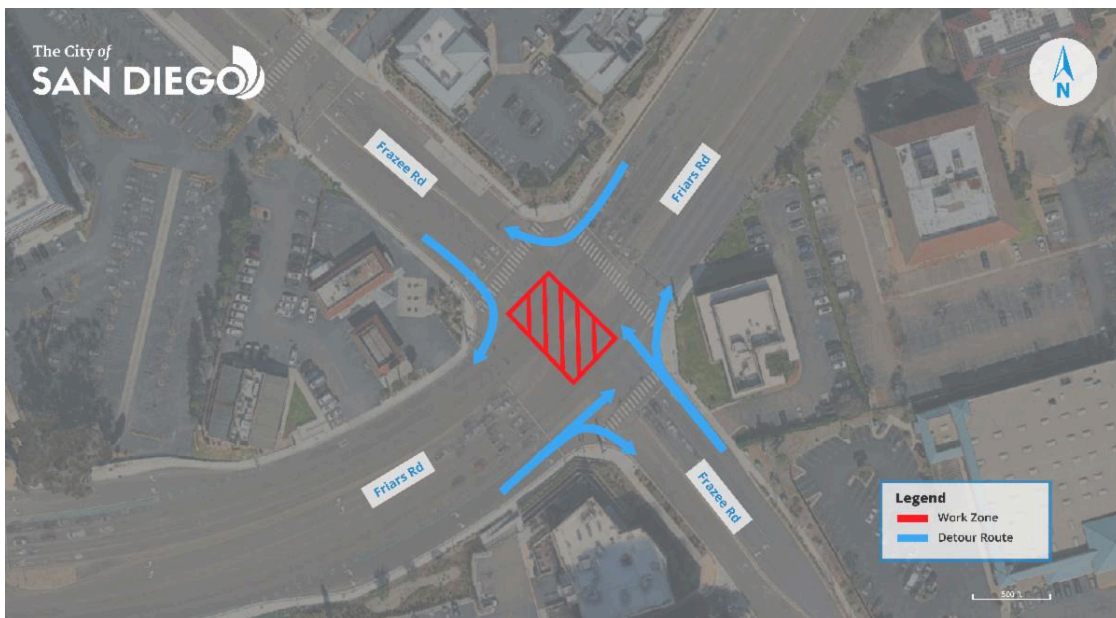
### Reminder: Upcoming Night Work and Planned Water Shutdowns

Crews on the City of San Diego's Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline project are making progress installing pipeline along Friars Road. Please see the project update below for upcoming portions of work.

#### Night Work at Friars Road and Frazee Road - Starting Sunday night April 12

- Crews will install pipeline through the intersection
- Working hours are 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday night through Friday morning
- This phase is currently expected to be completed by Friday, April 17
- During working hours, (9 p.m. to 5 a.m.), traffic will be limited through the intersection and detours may be required, please follow all posted signage
- During non-working hours, the intersection will be opened to traffic

The map below displays the traffic control that will be in place during night work hours, 9pm to 5am.



#### Water shutdown near Friars Road and Napa Street - Tuesday night April 14

- Water will be shut off April 14 at 8 p.m. until April 15 at 6 a.m.
- Water service will not be available throughout the shutoff time; please plan accordingly.
- Access to homes and for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
- Door hangers will be distributed in advance of the water shutdown occurring

### **Water shutdown near Friars Road and Frazee Road - Thursday night April 16**

- Water will be shut off April 16 at 8 p.m. until April 17 at 6 a.m.
- Water service will not be available throughout the shutoff time; please plan accordingly.
- Access to homes and for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
- Door hangers will be distributed in advance of the water shutdown occurring

To ensure everyone's safety, all construction activity will be contained within the marked work zone. After the pipeline has been installed, crews will temporarily pave over the trench before moving to the next section. Throughout this work, crews will maintain the cleanliness of the work zone to minimize any dust leaving.
