Load in will be on the same day as event at 6:00am and load out from 12:00pm-1:00pm. Event will have a DJ booth, community and vendor booths. Estimated attendance of 350.

STAFF RECOMENDATION: Approve the request as presented.

302. Bike MS Bay to Bay-Kristyn Evans, National MS Society

Request approval and support to host the two day organized cycling fundraiser at Crown Point on Sunday, October 18, 2026 from 5:00am-3:00pm. Load in will begin on Saturday, October 17, 2026 at 4:00am-5:00pm. Load out after event from 3:00pm-7:00pm. Event will have amplified music, beer garden, food trucks, and vendor booths. Event will also close down Crown Point North Parking Lot. Estimated attendance of 800.

STAFF RECOMENDATION: Approve the request as presented with the understanding if the Crown Point North Parking Lot is still under construction, the event will move to Crown Point South Parking Lot. They will take Senior Park Ranger, Richard Dhu's recommendation to close the section of the road from Moorland and the north entrance to Corona Oriente

Road, and add traffic control to ensure the safety of the participants near the finish line.
