

## **Morena Conveyance South & Middle: Final Resurfacing Upcoming in Bay Park**

The City of San Diego is excited to share continued progress on the Morena Conveyance South & Middle and Morena Conveyance Bike Lanes project. We extend our sincere gratitude to the Clairemont, Linda Vista, Bay Park and Bay Ho communities for your ongoing support and patience throughout this essential infrastructure project. 2026 is shaping up to be a major milestone year for the Pure Water Program.

### **Project Milestone: Pipeline Installation Complete**

The Morena Conveyance South and Middle Project has successfully completed installation of approximately 36,170 linear feet of 48-inch wastewater force main pipeline and approximately 36,170 linear feet of 30-inch welded steel pipe brine concentrate/conveyance pipeline. This achievement marks a significant milestone for Phase 1 of San Diego's Pure Water Program.

### **Final Resurfacing Begins in Bay Park**

On Thursday, May 21 through Friday, May 22, crews will begin final roadway resurfacing in the Bay Park community. Work will take place during daytime hours from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. within the Morena South & Middle alignment areas.

- Thursday, May 21: Jellett Street to Clairemont Drive
- Friday, May 22: Milton Street to Jellett Street

To ensure the safety of the workers and the public, traffic control measures will be in place throughout the work area. Residents and commuters are asked to follow posted signage, use caution, and follow all traffic control directions.

### **What To Expect**

- Traffic delays are expected; however, roads will generally remain open
- Avoid driving or walking through active work areas when possible
  - Oil used during resurfacing may stain carpets, floors, and other materials—please use caution
- Avoid turning vehicle wheels while stopped to protect the new surface.
- For a few days following the resurfacing, please drive at reduced speeds and avoid sharp turns to allow the new surface to properly set.
- Construction noise may be heard.
- Loose material is normal following resurfacing and will settle with traffic over time.
  - Street sweeping operations will be performed to collect loose material.
