STREET LIGHT CIRCUIT UPGRADE - TALMADGE PARK NORTH: This project provides for the upgrade of the 95-year old street lighting circuit from 5000v to 240v within the Talmadge Park North Area of Kensington to restore lighting to the area which has been out for several years.	EUCLID AND MONROE PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS: Series of traffic islands within a diamond-shaped intersection to regularize traffic flow and protect pedestrians. PFFP T-30.
2. Where is your suggested project located?	Loop created by East and West Alder Drive, Argos, & Hart terminating at Vista St on the west side.	Intersection of Euclid Ave. and Monroe Ave.
3. How will this project positively impact the community?	It will enhance public safety by restoring street lighting to an urbanized area within the city.	Project will provide pedestrian refuge at an intersection with extraordinarily high traffic volumes and lengthy crossing distances, 65', 71', 77', 102' feet. Additionally, it will regularize traffic flows by bring intersection closer to a series of 90 degree angles.

<p>EUCLID AND MONROE STORM DRAIN: Project provides for installation of missing storm water inlets in and around the intersection of Euclid & Monroe Avenues, as necessary, to prevent repeated flooding of private properties located on the south side of Monroe Ave. during each substantial rain event. PFFP T-1.7.</p>	<p>TALMADGE PARK: This project would provide for land acquisition, design and construction of a 1.0-acre public park at a site to be determined in Talmadge to serve existing and future residents. Amenities may include children's play area, passive seating and picnic areas, multi-purpose courts, drought tolerant landscaping, and open turf area for unstructured play. PFFP P-33.</p>	<p>ALDER & VISTA SIDEWALK INSTALLATION: On southeastern corner of intersection, install sidewalk where none exists, and widen a section of sidewalk which is non-ADA compliant. PFFP T-28.</p>
<p>4400 & 4500 blocks of Euclid Ave. and 4650 to 4800 blocks of Monroe Ave.</p>	<p>Near Monroe Ave. between intersection of Euclid Ave. and Aldine Dr. This area is both a CDBG eligible and Environmental Justice census tract. Other potential park sites may also be identified.</p>	<p>Intersection of 4200 block of Alder Drive and 4800 block of Vista St.</p>
<p>It would prevent flooding of nearby properties and the street. Downstream, it would reduce erosion of the cliffside abutting Aldine Drive. For best outcome, build project in conjunction with Euclid & Monroe pedestrian improvements.</p>	<p>Talmadge is 100% park deficient by current city standards.</p>	<p>Project would remove an unsafe condition where lack of a sidewalk forces pedestrians into the path of oncoming cars at a blind intersection. For best outcome, build project in conjunction with Talmadge Park North Circuit upgrade and undergrounding project. Evaluation of this project should consider the existing public rights-of-way and whether encroachments exist or not.</p>
