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**PROJECT NAME:** Design Consultant Services for Downtown Complete Streets Implementation Phase 3B2

**COMMUNITY PLAN AREA:** Downtown

**LOCATION:** The proposed project is located along Park Avenue between C Street and K Street.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Mayoral approval to award Design Consultant Services Task No. 25CP22 under Contract No. H2426413-M between the City of San Diego and Parsons for the Downtown Complete Streets 3B2 project. The design contract includes preliminary investigations, agency coordination, community outreach, conducting geotechnical borings and potholing, permit coordination, bid assistance, design support during construction, and various engineering and environmental technical reports.

Applications to appeal CEQA determination to the City Council must be filed in the Office of the City Clerk within five (5) business days from the date of the posting of this Notice (by May 29, 2026). Appeal procedures are described in Information Bulletin 505 (<https://www.sandiego.gov/sites/default/files/dsdib505.pdf>). Appeals to the City Clerk must be filed by email or in person as follows:

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked within five (5) business days of the date the appeal is filed.

Deposit the fully completed appeal application (including grounds for appeal and supporting documentation) to the City Administration Building – Public Information Counter (Open 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday excluding City-approved holidays), 1<sup>st</sup> Floor Lobby, located at 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101, by 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the appeal period. The completed appeal form shall include the required appeal fee, with a check payable to: City Treasurer. Please include the project name on the memo line of the check/money order. This Drop-Off Box is checked daily, and payments are processed the following business day.
