CHAIRPERSON'S REPORT: None

BOARDMEMBER COMMENT: Mary Harder expressed her worry about children being unattended and entering private property when using the park. Bill Klees mentioned that he will talk to his tenants about that situation.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

- **San Diego Parks Foundation** – Bill Klees mentioned that Rosamaria might be able to help step in for Martha Phillips.
- **Point Loma/Cabrillo Tennis Club**– Everything is going great.
- **Point Loma Summer Concerts**– 4 out of the 5 bands for the concerts have been picked. Concerts will start one day after the league finishes their tournament. There will be 4 concerts in July and 1 in August.
- **Point Loma Little League** – Brandon Anderson, who is on the board for the league, shared that this year they are at 535 which is a new record for them. Anderson then goes on to speak about wanting to expand and how they are always looking for fields at Dana and Cabrillo while making partnerships along the way and trying to better the fields as we go.

- **Surf Soccer** – Spring season has started and a couple 100 kids have been going on Fridays and Sundays. It was also shared that the competitive teams are forming for the new 26/27 season. They will be doing tryouts and should get over 500 kids again. High schoolers are returning after their high school seasons and are preparing for four teams going to the Southern California State tournament. There was also an inquiry about the plans for the abandoned building at NTC park and Carol Herrera provided an update about the debris being cleaned up, but the remaining walls could not be demolished.

101. General Area Report

Renovation of Cabrillo JU Field approval was received from Principal. Jerry is working with the city attorney to get the right of way entry. Brandon Anderson mentioned their idea to make Cabrillo JU Field more usable for their games. Mary wanted to know if we received feedback from the dog owners. Carol mentioned that it is not an off-leash park, but they are still able to use the field before permitted activities begin. Brandon also brought up the idea of putting up temporary fences when games are happening to delineate the field and the space for dogs.
