1) Update on RPTC Expansion Project

K. PARKS AND RECREATION STAFF REPORTS

Alex Davis, Area Manager, Rancho Peñasquitos:

- BMR Phase II project is moving forward. The bidding closed on March 3rd with four bidders; they were all over budget. There were eight things on the list that fit in the budget: Field and irrigation, wets, sidewalk, parking lot,

restrooms, courts and playground, dog park, dg path and lighting loop. The budget would allow for the first four things on list. The parking lot and restrooms would be next to the list if funding is available. Planning on signing the contract in the next few weeks.

- Pickleball is a big topic in the community right now. The next meeting will have some Pickleball representatives there for discussion about amending the GDP for Hilltop's basketball court.
- Planted five new trees. We removed a few dead trees at Views West and Hilltop Parks. We planted two trees at Views West and three at Hilltop.
