Please share specific infrastructure project ideas/ suggestions for your community?</p>	<p>The Torrey Hills Community Planning Board steadfastly requests that the City of San Diego invest Capital Improvement Projects funds into Torrey Hills Neighborhood Park pergolas and play structures. This park lacks any funding source and consequently maintenance has been neglected for its entire existence. There exists wooden pergolas that have not been painted in a quarter century. The paint is long gone and the wood is sun-beaten. One beam even exhibits a hole large enough to fit a softball. None of the drinking fountains work. There exists in multiple places exposed rusting rebar where concrete has broken away. The play structures are in a state of disrepair, the surface area under the swings is abraded and discolored from wear. The sand spills up out onto the sidewalks, occasionally causing bicycles to lose traction and crash.</p>	<p>The neglected strip of land on the west side of Torrey Hills Neighborhood Park between the wall and the walkway is an attractive nuisance. Gophers are unabated and frequently intrude into nearby homeowners' backyards. Furthermore the strip of land is a blight. The Torrey Hills Community Planning Board requests the City of San Diego invest Capital Improvement Projects funds into this strip of land, installing gopher block and root barriers to prevent further sidewalk lifting. We also request new, attractive vegetation and the irrigation necessary for the vegetation to thrive.</p>
