How to Speak to Items During Public Comment (In Person):

Public Comment on an Agenda Item: If you wish to address the Board on an item for today's agenda, please complete and submit a speaker form before the Board hears the agenda item. You will be called at the time the item is heard.

Public Comment on Matters Not on the Agenda: You may address the Board on any matter not listed on today's agenda. Please complete and submit a speaker form. However, California's open meeting laws do not permit the Board to discuss or take any action on the matter at today's meeting. At its discretion, the Board may add the item to a future meeting agenda or refer the matter to staff or committee. Individuals' comments are limited to three minutes per speaker. At the discretion of the Chair, if a large number of people wish to speak on the same item, comments may be limited to a set period of time per item.

How to Speak to Items During Public Comment (Virtual):

When the Chair introduces the item you would like to comment on (or indicates it is time for Non-Agenda Public Comment), raise your hand by either tapping the "Raise Your Hand" button on your computer, tablet, or Smartphone, or by dialing *9 on your phone. You will be taken in

the order in which you raised your hand. You may only speak once on a particular item. When the Chair indicates it is your turn to speak, click the unmute prompt that will appear on your computer, tablet or Smartphone, or dial *6 on your phone.

How to Provide Written Comments:

Written Materials: You may submit written materials via email to ResiliencyBoard@sandiego.gov or via U.S. Mail to Attn: Resiliency Advisory Board 202 C Street, MS 413 San Diego, CA 92101. Materials submitted via U.S. Mail must be received the business day prior to the meeting to be distributed to the Resiliency Advisory Board. Comments received by 8:00 AM the day of the meeting will be distributed to the Resiliency Advisory Board and posted online with the meeting materials. Comments received after the deadlines described above but before the item is called will be submitted into written record for the relevant item. Please Note: Documents related to the Resiliency Advisory Board meeting agenda items which are distributed to the Board prior to the meeting are available for public review in the 1st floor lobby of the City Administration Building, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101.
