Man Arrested in Core-Columbia Stabbing Homicide

San Diego – On June 15, 2026, at 12:48 A.M., San Diego Police Communications received a report of a stabbing. When officers arrived, they found the victim unresponsive with at least one stab wound. First aid was rendered by officers until medics arrived and transported the victim to a local hospital, where he later died.

At this time, the victim has not been identified. He is described as a White male in his 30's or 40's. Detectives and the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office will work together to confirm his identity.

Nearby surveillance footage captured the incident. The suspect, described as a White male in dark clothing, was last seen walking east along West "C" Street at Front Street.

Due to the proximity to the crime scene, trolley service was temporarily restricted but has since resumed. Vehicle traffic is shut down for the 300 and 200 blocks of West "C" Street and 1100 Union Street in both directions; however, pedestrian access to the courthouse is open.

At about 8:10 A.M., MTS security called SDPD and advised they contacted a person matching the suspect's description at the Imperial Trolley Station, located at 1255 Imperial Avenue. Officers arrived and took the man, 22-year-old Conrad Waldron, into custody without incident. Waldron will be booked into County Jail for murder.

The Homicide Unit is handling the investigation. Detectives will be in the area throughout the day, reviewing surveillance footage, collecting evidence, and identifying witnesses.
