Alvarado 2nd Extension Pipeline Project

Project Update and Upcoming Water Shutdown

Crews on the Project are continuing to work at select locations on Friars Road between Frazee Road and Qualcomm Way to install 48'-inch valves and related components along the pipeline alignment during daytime hours. These valves help control the flow of water in major pipelines, while the associated components support safe operation by regulating pressure, protecting the pipeline, and maintaining efficient performance. Traffic control will be in place to accommodate excavation and installation of the valves. This portion of work is expected to complete by the end of the week, Friday, May 22.

During the week of May 25, crews will be replacing curb ramps near the Mission Center Road and Friars Road intersection to bring them up to current ADA standards. This work is expected to be completed by Friday, May 29.

On Sunday, May 31, crews will perform an overnight water shutdown at the Frazee Road and Friars Road intersection from Sunday, May 31 at 8 p.m. to Monday, June 1, at 6 a.m. Door hangers will be distributed in advance to addresses expected to be impacted by the water shutdown. Additional email updates will also be sent in advance of the water shutdown.

To ensure everyone's safety, all construction activity will be contained within the marked work zone. After the pipeline has been installed, crews will temporarily pave over the trench before moving to the next section. Throughout this work, crews will maintain the cleanliness of the work zone to minimize any dust leaving.
