CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Night Work along Genesee Avenue at Governor Drive and Centurion Square

Beginning on the evening of Tuesday, June 9, the City of San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels' contractor will be working at night on Genesee Avenue to complete pavement base repair work as preparation for final paving. Crews will work on Genesee Avenue at Centurion Square and at the intersection of Genesee Avenue and Governor Drive.

Work hours will take place from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night, and crews will alternate working nights at Centurion Square and at the Governor Drive intersection. Traffic impacts resulting from this work are outlined below.

Genesee Avenue and Governor Drive Intersection

- Two traffic control configurations will be used to complete this work.
- Traffic signal will be flashing red.
- Please see maps below further detailing traffic impacts and detours.
- *Detour 1*
 - Governor Drive will be closed to eastbound and westbound traffic.
 - Single lane open on northbound and southbound Genesee Avenue.
 - Eastbound traffic on Governor Drive detoured to Radcliffe Drive to Radcliffe Lane to travel north or south on Genesee Avenue.
 - Southbound on Genesee to SR-52 to I-805 to return to Governor Drive.
 - Westbound traffic on Governor Drive detoured to Edmonton Avenue to Calgary Avenue to travel northbound on Genesee Avenue to make a U-turn at Centurion Square to continue southbound on Genesee Avenue to return to Governor Drive.
- *Detour 2*
 - Governor Drive will be closed to eastbound and westbound traffic.
 - Single lane open on northbound and southbound Genesee Avenue.
 - Detours at Radcliffe Lane and Edmonton Avenue.

What to Expect:

- Electronic message boards will be placed as advanced notification about the traffic control shift.
- Parking restrictions will be enforced; please avoid parking in areas with "no parking" signs. Vehicles in violation of these signs will be towed.
- 24/7 access for emergency vehicles, residences and businesses will be maintained.
- Please anticipate traffic delays and construction noise.
- For safety reasons, please follow all posted signs including detours for traffic.

The City and project team are committed to completing construction as safely and efficiently as possible, and the University City community's patience and coordination are appreciated. Please note that construction schedules are subject to change at any time.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's advanced water purification program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035 and significantly reduce treated discharges from the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant. Pure Water San Diego will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The phased, multi-year program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water and wastewater needs. San Diegans are getting dual value from this investment — reliable, sustainable drinking water and avoided wastewater costs. The Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on utc.purewatersd.org.
