CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Night Work at Genesee Avenue and Nobel Drive Intersection

Night work is scheduled for Monday, June 15, and Tuesday, June 16, at the intersection of Genesee Avenue and Nobel Drive. The City of San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels contractor will complete pavement base repair work in preparation for final paving.

Work will take place each night from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Two traffic control configurations will be used during construction, and the traffic signal will flash red during both. Traffic impacts are outlined below, and detours are shown on the accompanying maps.

Detour 1

The intersection will be closed to westbound traffic and partially closed to eastbound traffic. Westbound traffic on Nobel Drive will be detoured to Towne Centre Drive to La Jolla Village Drive to Regents Road to return to Nobel Drive. Eastbound traffic will be detoured to Cargill Avenue to Decoro Street to travel north on Genesee and turn back onto Nobel Drive to continue traveling east.

Detour 2

Work will occur at the center of the intersection. Eastbound traffic on Nobel Drive will be detoured around the work zone by turning onto southbound Genesee Avenue and making a U-turn at Decoro street to travel north on Genesee Avenue and returning east on Nobel Drive. Westbound traffic will be detoured north on Genesee Avenue to make a U-turn at La Jolla Village Drive to return traveling west on Nobel Drive.

What to Expect:

- Electronic message boards will provide advance notice of traffic control changes.
- Parking restrictions will be enforced. Please do not park in posted no-parking areas; vehicles in violation will be towed.
- Access for emergency vehicles, residents, and businesses will be maintained at all times.
- Please expect traffic delays and construction noise during work hours.
- For your safety, please follow all posted signs and traffic detours.

The City and project team are committed to completing construction as safely and efficiently as possible, and the University City community's patience and coordination are appreciated. Please note that construction schedules are subject to change at any time.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's advanced water purification program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035 and

significantly reduce treated discharges from the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant. Pure Water San Diego will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The phased, multi-year program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water and wastewater needs. San Diegans are getting dual value from this investment — reliable, sustainable drinking water and avoided wastewater costs. The Morena Northern Pipelines and Tunnels project is one of several major water infrastructure projects in Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on utc.purewatersd.org.
