### **AGENDA ITEMS**

#### **ITEM 1: 6794 LA JOLLA BOULEVARD – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1107307**

**Staff:** Francisco Mendoza

**City Council District:** 1

**Plan Area:** La Jolla

An application for a Special Use Permit (processed as a Site Development Permit), Coastal Development Permit, and Neighborhood Development Permit for the construction of a three-story 3,156-square-foot single-dwelling unit (two stories over an existing surface parking lot) spanning two mixed-use lots, along with associated site improvements.

The 6,729-square-foot lot is located at 6794 La Jolla Boulevard in the LJPD-4 (La Jolla Planned District, Zone 4) Zone, the Coastal Overlay Zone (Non-Appealable), the Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone, and a Transit Priority Area within the La Jolla Community Plan.

The project requests two deviations: 1) To increase the allowable Floor Area Ratio from 1.0 to 1.225, resulting in a total of 8,244.25 square feet of development, where 6,729 square feet is permitted, and 2) To allow three stories where the La Jolla Planned District limits development to two stories. This development is within the Coastal Overlay Zone and the application was filed on December 13, 2023.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to sections 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) and 15332 (In-Fill Development).

**ITEM 2: WHALE VIEW POINT STAIRS – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1146375****Staff:** Spencer Deane**City Council District:** 1**Plan Area:** La Jolla

An application for a Coastal Development Permit and Site Development Permit to repair and restore the Whale View Point Stairs. The project includes cleaning and repairing the historic concrete stairs and adjoining masonry walls, capping of the historic treads, risers, and cobblestone side walls with precast concrete pavers and mortar and painting the existing handrail and wooden posts. The stairway is a contributing structure to the La Jolla Park Coastal Historic District.

The 0.0034-acre project site is located partially within the public right-of-way and the coastal bluff within the coastal park west of 417 Coast Boulevard South. The site is in the LJPD-5 (La Jolla Planned District, Zone 5) Zone, the Coastal Overlay Zone (Appealable, First Public Roadway), and the Sensitive Coastal Overlay Zone within the La Jolla Community Plan. The development is within the Coastal Overlay Zone and the application was filed on October 27, 2025.

This project was determined to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15331 (Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation).

## HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN HEARING OFFICER HEARINGS

### **TO SPEAK TO A PARTICULAR ITEM DURING PUBLIC COMMENT:**

**In Person for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment:** Please fill out a speaker slip located at the entrance to the meeting. Indicate the item you wish to speak on as well as other requested information. Then submit it to City staff.

**Via Virtual Platform for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment:** When the Hearing Officer introduces the item (or indicates it is time for Non-Agenda Public Comment), raise your hand by either tapping the “Raise Your Hand” button on your computer, tablet, or Smartphone, or by dialing \*9 on your phone. You will be taken in the order in which you raised your hand. You may only speak once on a particular item. When the Hearing Officer indicates it is your turn to speak, unmute your phone by tapping the unmute button on your computer, tablet or Smartphone, or dial \*6 on your phone.

Please Note: Members of the public who wish to provide virtual testimony must enter the virtual queue by raising their hand before the queue closes. The queue will close when the last virtual speaker finishes speaking or five minutes after in-person testimony ends, whichever happens first. *Those participating virtually may NOT cede time to others participating in person or virtually.*

### **HOW TO PROVIDE WRITTEN COMMENTS:**

Materials submitted via U.S. Mail must be received the business day prior for it to be distributed to the Hearing Officer.

### **Late-Arriving Materials:**
