About the Plan

The San Diego Citywide Trails Master Plan will guide the equitable and environmentally responsible development, enhancement, and construction of existing and new trails throughout the city. In addition to trails within the City's open space, the Trails Master Plan will also include urban pathways and other community connections.

Trails Master Plan will serve as a framework for future trail planning, emphasizing the integration between trail development, open space planning, conservation and connections to and within our communities. The plan will help ensure that trails are accessible and enjoyable for San Diegans of all ages and abilities while supporting the protection of sensitive plants and animals.

Master Plan Goals

The Trails Master Plan will provide a framework for the provision and enhancement of the City's trail system. Through goals, policies, design guidelines, and clear implementation actions, it will provide a vision for a trail system that:

- Enhances recreational opportunities
- Connects the places we live, work and play
- Supports physical activity, including walking, rolling, and biking
- Protects sensitive plants and animals
- Improves trail access, safety and user experience

Meaningful and inclusive public engagement is critical to ensuring that the Trails Master plan serves the needs of all San Diegans. In partnership with local community-based organizations, the City will provide a variety of engagement opportunities for community members to guide the development of the Trails Master Plan.

Existing Conditions Report



The Existing Conditions Report will compile and analyze the City's existing trail system, incorporating both quantitative data such as the location and length of trails, as well as qualitative data such as trail condition and user experience. The report will identify opportunities to improve and expand the existing trail network and inform development of the Trails Master Plan.

Trails Master Plan



Grounded in community input and informed by the Existing Conditions Report, the Trails Master Plan will guide future trail planning, design standards and an implementation strategy. The plan will integrate community feedback, technical findings and implementation strategies into a cohesive framework for enhancing, expanding, and connecting the City's trail network.
