

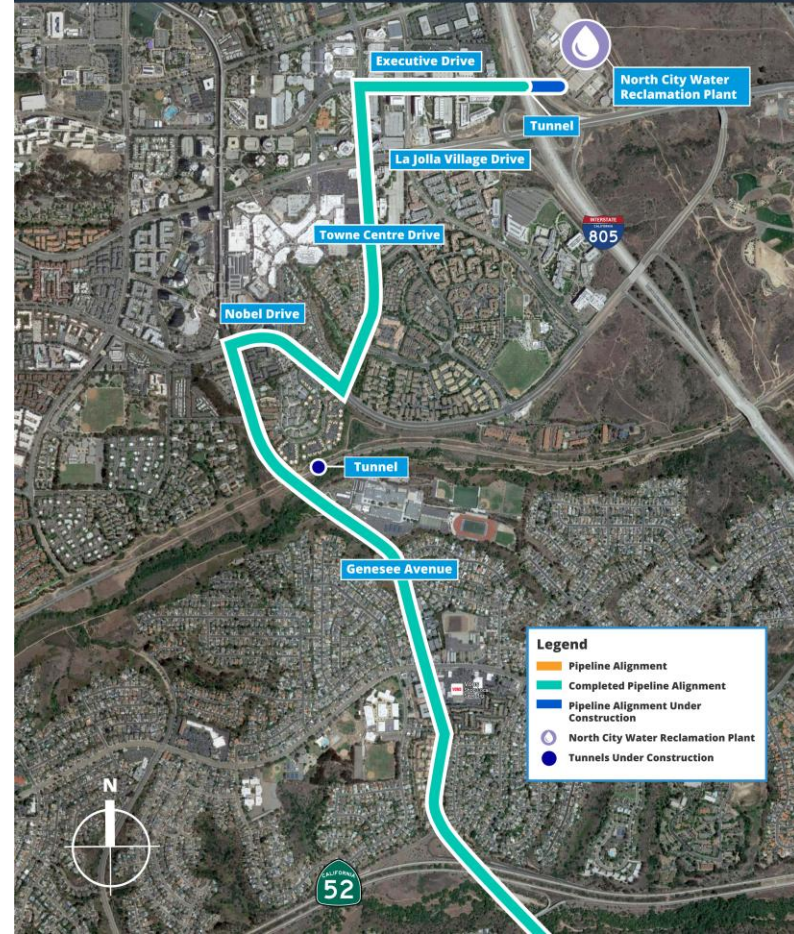


Pure Water San Diego Morena Northern Pipelines & Tunnels Project Update



Recently Completed and Ongoing Work:

- Continued work on medians along Genesee Avenue
- Completed base repair and paving overlay work along most of project alignment
 - Remaining paving segments: Calgary Avenue to Decoro Street on Genesee Avenue & Executive Drive from Judicial Drive to end of street (east)
- All curb ramps in ROW installed and upgrades complete along project alignment
- Continued work at I-805 tunnel launch (Executive Dr) & receiving shaft (Water Reclamation Plant)
- Marian Bear Park re-open for community use



Current Work Sites

Genesee Avenue/SR-52



- Intermittent traffic controls anticipated throughout project completion
- Curb ramps & concrete sidewalks are complete
- Final paving complete and striping to follow soon

Marian Bear Park



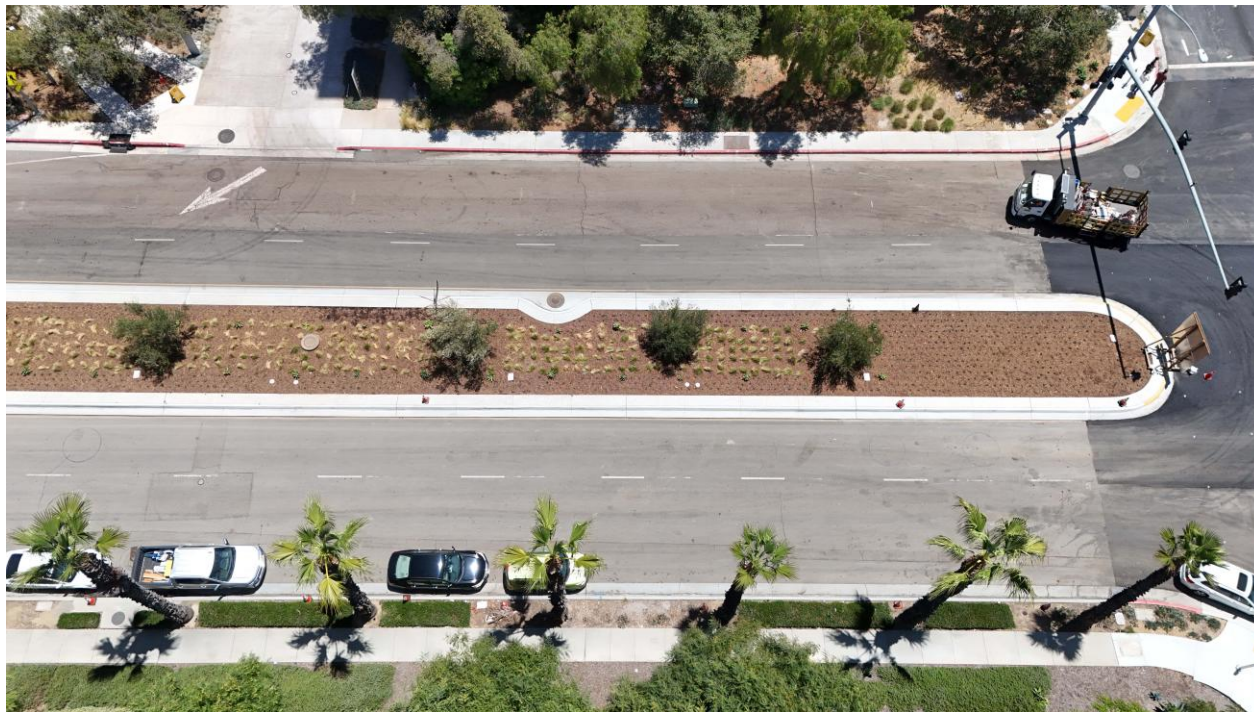
- Crews have completed hydroseeding and revegetation activities

Upcoming Work

Nobel Drive



- Medians on Nobel Dr. will be restored, including replanting of trees
- Replanting will include White Crepe Myrtles

Appurtenances Work



- Ongoing along the alignment
- May see crews working intermittently at vaults and sidewalks to complete remaining mechanical and electrical work
- Most of this work will take place underground
- Traffic control will be in place; for your safety, please follow all posted signs and detours

Final Paving and Striping

- Beginning in July, street reconfiguration will occur, pending the completion of final paving activities
- Led by the Transportation Department and consistent with the City's Mobility Master Plan & University City Plan
- These bikeways will help create a more complete and integrated transportation network throughout University City and include:
 - Class II – Striped on-street bike lanes
 - Class IV – Protected/separated bike lanes
- Bikeways will create safer, more connected routes that improve mobility, enhance street safety and support community plan goals for complete streets.
- Additional notification will be provided to inform community about final striping schedule

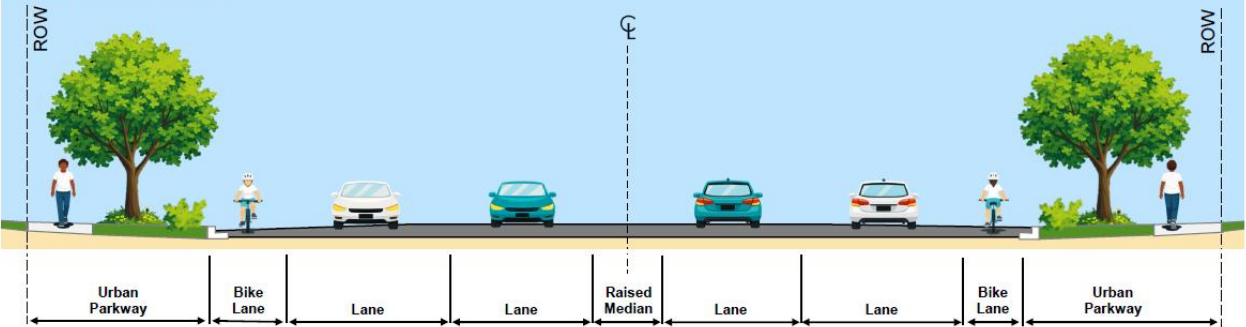

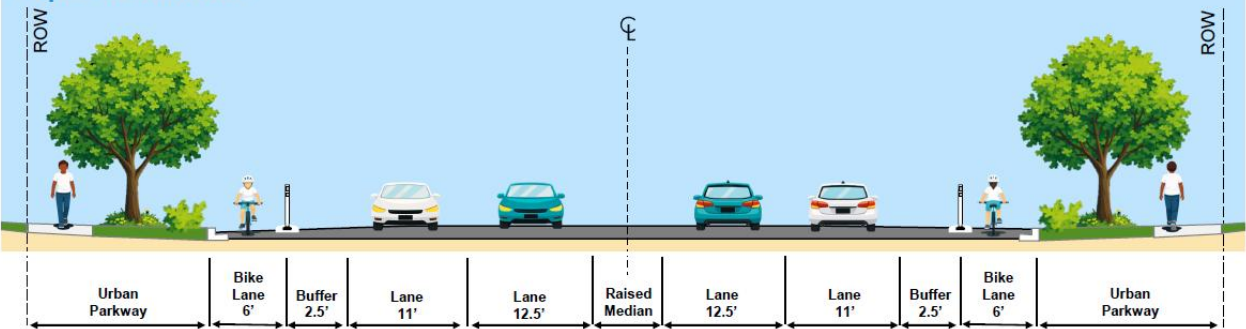


Genesee Ave. (Appleton St. to Nobel Dr.)

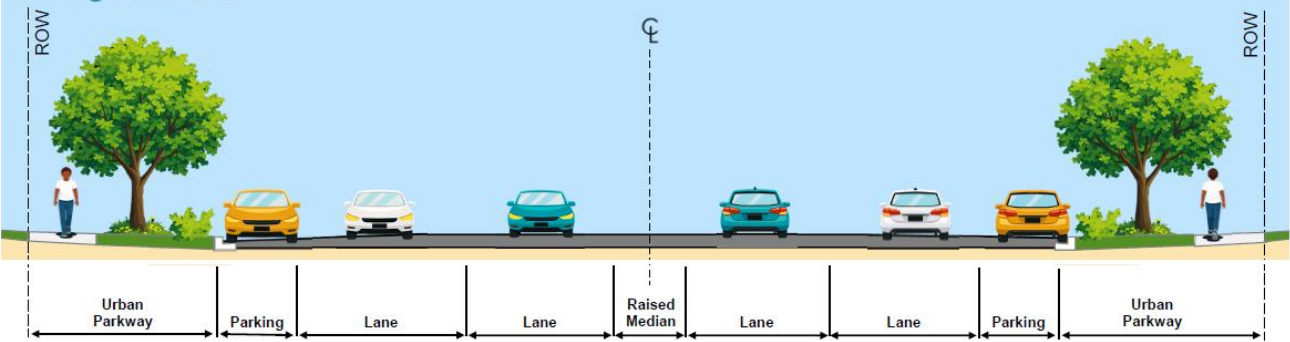

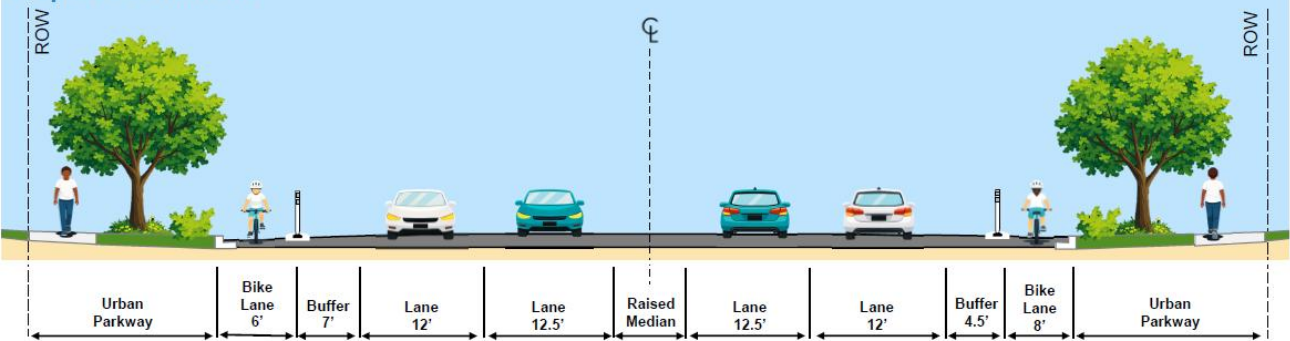
Nobel Dr. (Genesee Ave. to Towne Centre Dr.)

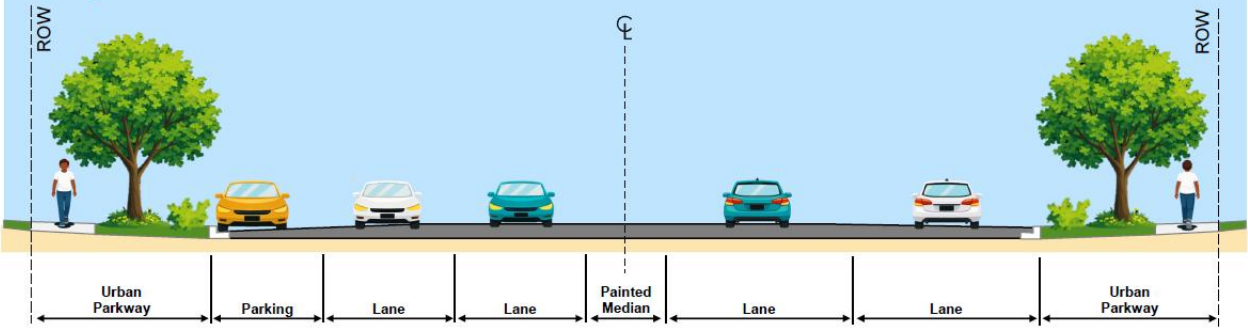

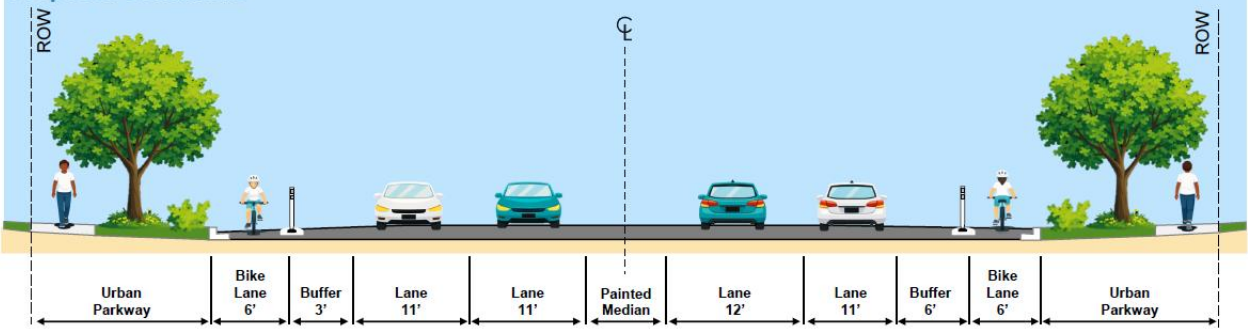
Towne Centre Dr. (Nobel Dr. to Executive Dr.)

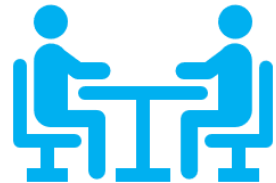
