Plan Area: Carmel Mountain Ranch

An application for a Tentative Map to convert 45 commercial units of an existing 3-story building into commercial condominium units with no physical changes. The 3.08-acre site is located at 12396 World Trade Drive (APN: 313-540-0900) within the Industrial Light (IL-2-1) zone, a Transit Priority Area (TPA), the Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone (VHFSZ), Prime Industrial Lands, Complete Communities Mobility Choices Mobility Zone 4, the Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (MCAS Miramar), and an Airport Influence Area (MCAS Miramar Review Area 2). No construction is proposed with this project, and the site is fully developed.

The project was determined to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15301 (Existing Facilities).

ITEM 2: *11085 TORREYANA ROAD – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1056938

City Council District: 1

Plan Area: University

An application for a Coastal Development Permit and Neighborhood Development Permit for the demolition of two existing structures and the

construction of a Scientific Research and Development Facility totaling up to 122,980 square feet of building area. Various site improvements are proposed, including an extended fire access lane, hardscape, landscape and improvements within the public right-of-way. A Multiple Habitat Planning Area (MHPA) Boundary Line Correction would remove a 0.13-acre portion of the site that was legally permitted and developed prior to adoption of the Multiple Species Conservation Plan Subarea Plan.

The 6.15-acre site is located at 11085 and 11095 Torreyana Road within the University Community Plan and Local Coastal Program (UCP). The site is also in in the IP-1-1 (Industrial Park) zone, the Coastal Overlay Zone (Appealable Area, First Public Roadway), the Coastal Height Limitation Overlay Zone, the Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (ALUCOZ) and Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP) area for Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Miramar, the ALUCP Airport Influence Area (AIA) for MCAS Miramar (Review Area 1), the Accident Potential Zone II (APZ-II) for MCAS Miramar, the Coastal Parking Impact Overlay Zone, Complete Communities Mobility Choices Mobility Zone 2, a Transit Priority Area, a Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone (VHFSZ), Prime Industrial Lands, and the Community Plan Implementation Overlay Zone Type B (CPIOZ-B). This development is within the Coastal Overlay Zone, and the application was filed on May 3, 2022.

The project is being processed as an Expedite Program project for Sustainable Buildings and is eligible based on Council Policy 600-27 and San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) Section 143.0915 for Non-Residential projects that incorporate the Mandatory and Voluntary Tier I and Tier II measures of Title 24, Part 11 California Green Building Standards Code (CGBSC).

A [Subsequent Mitigated Negative Declaration NO. PRJ-1056938/SCH No. 201960003 to Program Environmental Impact Report \(PEIR\) State Clearinghouse \(SCH\) No. 2019060003](#) was prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act Statute and Guidelines. A Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) will be implemented.

ITEM 3: *7354 ROMERO DRIVE VARIANCE – PROJECT NO. PRJ-1101825

Plan Area: La Jolla

An application for a Coastal Development Permit and Variance for the remodel and addition of an existing one-story, 3,435-square-foot single-family residence, adding 3,232 square feet in two additional floors (for a total of three stories and 6,667 square feet of construction). Additionally, 495 square feet of interior space will be converted into an Accessory Dwelling Unit. The 0.297-acre site is located at 7354 Romero Drive in the RS-1-4 (Residential Single) zone, the Coastal Overlay zone (Non-Appealable), and the Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone within the La Jolla Community Plan area.

This development is within the Coastal Overlay Zone and the application was filed on August 25, 2023.

A CEQA Guideline Section 15162 Consistency Evaluation was prepared against previously certified [Environmental Impact Report \(EIR\) No. 92-0199/SCH No. 92071032](#) as this activity is within the scope of the and the EIR adequately describes the activity for the purposes of CEQA.

Via Virtual Platform for Agenda Items and Non-Agenda Public Comment: When the Hearing Officer introduces the item (or indicates it is time for Non-Agenda Public Comment), raise your hand by either tapping the “Raise Your Hand” button on your computer, tablet, or Smartphone, or by dialing *9 on your phone. You will be taken in the order in which you raised your hand. You may only speak once on a particular item. When the Hearing Officer indicates it is your turn to speak, unmute your phone by tapping the unmute button on your computer, tablet or Smartphone, or dial *6 on your phone.

Please Note: Members of the public who wish to provide virtual testimony must enter the virtual queue by raising their hand before the queue closes.
