102. Item 102. Request to establish proposed San Diego River Crossing Bridge as Capital Improvement Project – *Councilmember Campillo, Chair Mission Trails Regional Park Task Force*

- Per a recommendation from the MTRP Citizens' Advisory Committee to make the River Crossing Bridge a Capital Improvement Project, following the completion of funding and a Stop Work Order from the Lenail Family. The bridge project has been a long-standing item on the MTRP Master Plan Update Implementation Priorities list. If the bridge is not able to be built through private funding, Campillo will continue to advocate for it as a City-sponsored project.
- It was moved and seconded (Campillo, Suzuki) to make the San Diego Bridge a CIP. Motion carried unanimously 4-0.
