

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE
North City Pure Water Pipeline Nighttime Construction
Scheduled on Eastgate Mall

July 10, 2026

As part of the City of San Diego North City Pure Water Pipeline project, an overnight closure of Eastgate Mall between Olson Drive and Eastgate Court is scheduled for July 13 to 16, from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Eastgate Mall will be open during the day.

Following the week of July 13, the road closure will be lifted while pipeline construction progresses on Eastgate Mall, and traffic will be controlled by flaggers as required around the active work zone.

All businesses will remain open and accessible during construction, please plan additional time when traveling overnight on Eastgate Mall and expect delays. Please follow all posted signage and crew member directions for safety.

Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's advanced water purification program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035 and significantly reduce treated discharges from the Point Loma Wastewater Treatment Plant. Pure Water San Diego will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water.

The phased, multi-year program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water and wastewater needs. San Diegans are getting dual value from this investment — reliable, sustainable drinking water and avoided wastewater costs. The North City Pure Water Pipeline project is one of several major infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego. The pipeline starts on Eastgate Mall and follows Miramar Road to Kearny Villa Road and continues along Candida Street to Via Pasar and Via Excelencia. From there, the pipeline tunnels under Interstate 15. On the east side of Interstate 15, it continues along Businesspark Avenue to Carroll Canyon Road and follows Hoyt Park Drive to Meanley Drive before crossing Scripps Lake Drive to the Miramar Reservoir.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the project alignment will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on scrippsran.ch.purewatersd.org.
