Beach Fire Ring Rules, Location, and Count

Fires on City of San Diego Beaches

- Beach fires can only be built in City provided fire rings or contained within a portable propane-fueled device.
- Only charcoal, clean wood, or paper can be burned in City provided fire rings (no pallets or rubbish).
- Do not leave a fire burning unattended. Wait until the fire has burned out or extinguish it with water. Do not use sand to put a fire out.
- No beach fires between 12:00 am and 5:00 am.
- Fire rings are available on a first-come, first-served basis.**
- Availability is subject to change due to maintenance and/or replacement of fire rings.**
- Summer only = Mid-March to Mid-September.
