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Mira Mesa Shooting Determined to be Murder Suicide

San Diego – Shortly before 7:00 p.m., on August 7, 2026, San Diego Police Department officers responded to neighbors reporting suspicious activity at a residence in the 10100 block of Summerview Court in the Mira Mesa neighborhood.

Officers arrived to find a woman and man down inside the garage. The woman was pronounced dead at the scene. The man sustained an apparent gunshot wound to his upper torso and was transported by San Diego Fire-Rescue paramedics to a local trauma center, where he later died. The San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit assumed responsibility for the investigation.

The investigation has since revealed that the two decedents were a married couple that lived at the residence. They have now been identified as 61-year-old Todd Teresi, and 78-year-old Tere Silentwater-Teresi. This appears to be an incident of domestic violence in which the husband shot his wife and turned the gun on himself. The firearm used was recovered on scene. No outstanding suspects are being sought.
