De Anza Cove, Mission Bay Park

Event Overview

Exercise Your Faith 5K is a faith-centered community wellness event hosted by B.U.F.F. (Believers United For Fitness). The event encourages healthy living while bringing together runners, walkers, churches, local businesses, and families. Participants will experience a scenic 5K along the Mission Bay waterfront followed by fellowship, wellness activities, food, and community engagement. The event is designed for up to 500 registered participants.

Event Features

- Scenic 5K out-and-back course on paved pathways.
- Registration and participant check-in.
- Group warm-up and stretching.
- Prayer and communion before the race.
- Up to 10 community vendor booths.
- Up to 2 food trucks.
- Wellness recovery area with stretching and a proposed cold plunge activation (pending approval).
- Hydration and refreshments.
- Awards presentation and fellowship.

Course Description

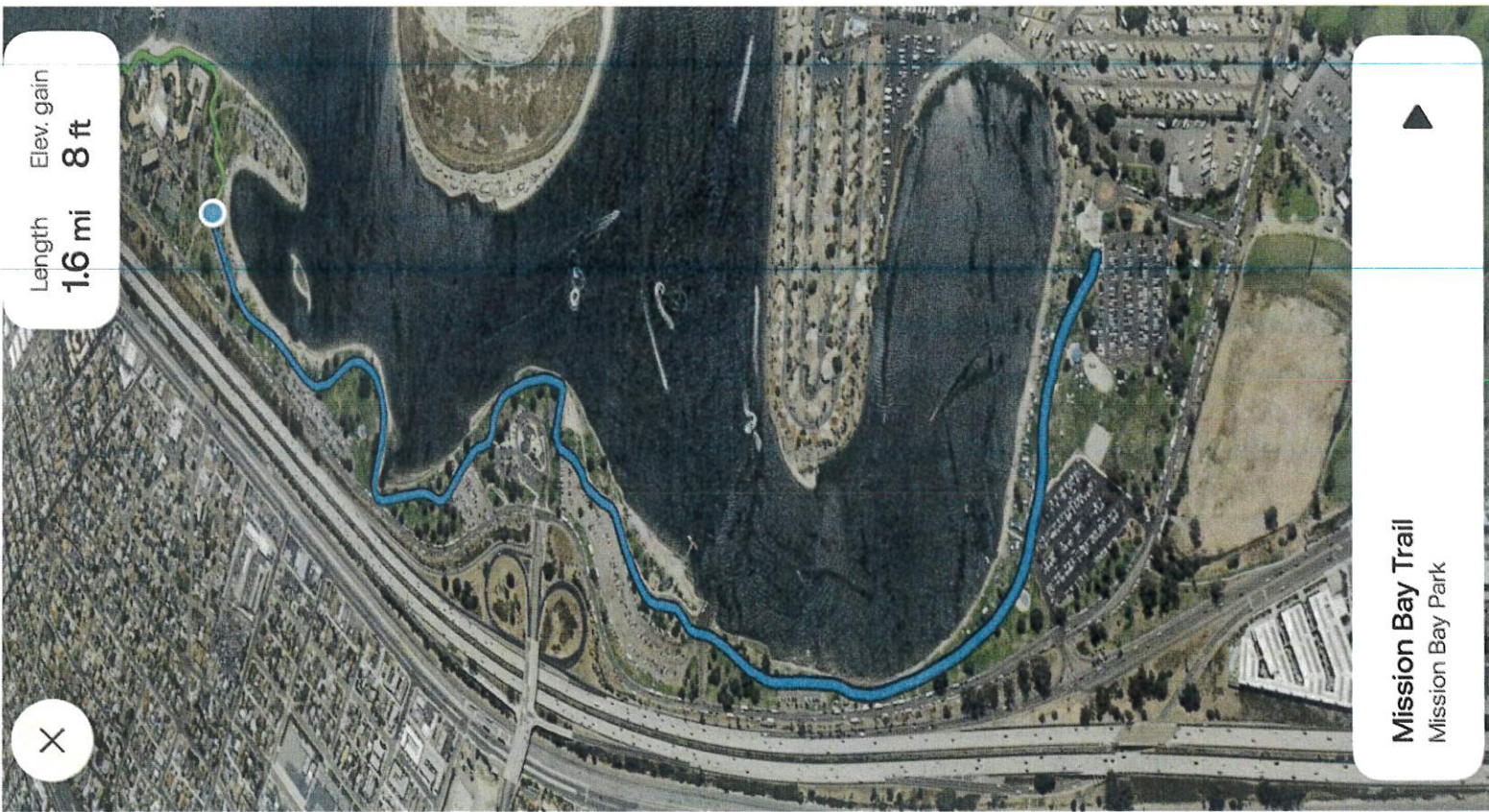
The race begins at De Anza Cove and follows the paved Mission Bay recreational path for approximately 1.55 miles to a staffed turnaround featuring volunteers and a hydration station. Participants return along the same route to complete the 5K (3.1 miles). The course is flat, paved, and suitable for runners, walkers, families, and strollers.

Proposed Timeline

- 6:00 AM – Event setup begins.
- 7:30 AM – Registration and vendor check-in opens.
- 8:00 AM – Vendor village opens.
- 9:15 AM – Participant announcements and safety briefing.
- 9:30 AM – Group warm-up and stretching.
- 9:45 AM – Prayer and communion.
- 10:00 AM – Exercise Your Faith 5K starts.
- 10:25 AM – First finishers expected.
- 10:30 AM–11:30 AM – Finish line celebration, recovery activities, vendor engagement, and refreshments.
- 11:45 AM – Awards and participant recognition.
- 12:00 PM–1:30 PM – Community fellowship and food trucks.
- 2:00 PM – Event concludes and cleanup begins.

Operations

Existing parking areas and permanent restrooms at De Anza Cove will be utilized. The event footprint will remain within the approved permit area. Volunteers will monitor waste collection throughout the event, and a complete cleanup will be performed immediately following breakdown to ensure the park is left in excellent condition.
