

SAND VOLLEYBALL RULES

- 1. Court Use:** Courts numbered #1, #2, #3, #11, #12, #13 and #14 are open to the public on a first-come, first-served basis. Exception: Courts #1 - #3 may be permitted in conjunction with Courts #4 - #10.
- 2.** A minimum 20-foot-wide access lane must be kept around the perimeter of the set of volleyball courts at all times. The volleyball poles may not be moved and must remain two courts wide.
- 3.** Balls, lines and nets are not provided. Bring your own equipment. All equipment must be removed after each use. Equipment may not be left overnight. Deep anchoring is prohibited.
- 4.** Court hours are Monday – Sunday from 6 a.m. to dusk. Portable lights are prohibited.
- 5.** Portable nets systems are prohibited in permanent court area. Portable net systems are allowed in the Open Sand Area by Cape May by permit only.
- 6. Open Play Rules:** Courts numbered #1, #2, #3, #11, #12, #13 and #14
 - The open-to-public courts will be on a first-come, first-served basis for open play.
 - These courts may not be used for organized camps, clinics, practices, or tournaments.
