

SAND VOLLEYBALL RULES

- 1. Court Use:** Courts numbered #5 - #14 are open to the public on a first-come, first-served basis. Exceptions: The four courts located at the north end #1, #2, #3 and #4 may be permitted through the Parks and Recreation Permit Center. At the discretion of the Permit Center, additional courts may be reserved for Parks and Recreation Youth Clinics and three traditional tournaments.
- 2.** A minimum 20-foot-wide access lane must be kept around the perimeter of the set of volleyball courts at all times.
- 3.** Balls are not provided. Bring your own equipment.
- 4.** Court hours are Monday – Sunday from 6 a.m. to dusk. Portable lights are prohibited.
- 5.** Portable nets systems are prohibited in permanent court area.
- 6. Open Play Rules: Courts #5 - #14**
 - The open-to-public courts will be on a first-come, first-served basis for open play.
 - These courts may not be used for organized camps, clinics, practices, or tournaments.
