- Discussion Item 1: Pedestrianizing Ray Street - Presentation from RideSD
 - RideSD is gathering community input re: Ray Street
 1. Priorities:
 - a. Safety
 - b. Greenspace
 - c. Clarity for drivers
 2. Options:
 - a. Bollards
 - b. Cul-De-Sac
 - c. Full road closure
 3. Issues:
 - a. Target access?
 - b. Cost
 - i. May be worthwhile to focus upon bollards, quick build solutions
- Discussion Item 2: CIP Process Review, Next Steps - *after the CIP has been ratified, further steps to communicate and gather support for these priorities will be needed.*
 - Quick discussion on this - we reviewed a few options for focus, like CIP #1, the El Cajon Blvd Fork (may be covered by a future roundabout)
 1. Malachi noted this could be inevitable, Edgar spoke about opportunities to fold into the Normal Street Promenade
 2. Johanna has some connections, could reach out to see status. Will follow up on this offline
 3. Krishna: could be our opportunity to build consensus, because a roundabout will be controversial
 - Quick build opportunities, like the Triangle Islands (see CIP #3) => Krishna will work up a potential proposal on this to present to the subcommittee
 - We won't send this back to the board, because this is primarily for our subcommittee's next steps
- Item 4: Entertainment Zones was unfinished - *Discuss creation of an entertainment zone in North Park*
 - Brief discussion of entertainment zones allowing for alcoholic consumption on limited streets, potential for interventions like the Ray Street promenade or

otherwise. We had a suggestion of a specially colored cup to indicate it is authorized for a given area
