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Two Adults and One Teen Found Dead in Home in Lake Murray

San Diego – On September 16, 2026, at approximately 8:18 a.m., San Diego Police officers from Eastern Division responded to a 9-1-1 call reporting two people unresponsive and not breathing inside a home in the 6800 block of Boulder Lake Ave. in the Lake Murray neighborhood.

The caller said she found the couple, a husband and wife, inside the residence and was concerned about the whereabouts of the couple's teenage daughter.

Officers arrived within minutes and assessed the victims, a 56-year-old man, and 54-year-old woman, for signs of life. Both were pronounced deceased at the scene. During these efforts, the couple's teenage daughter was also found deceased in the home.

Detectives from the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit responded and assumed responsibility for the investigation. Preliminary evidence at the scene indicates all three died from gunshot wounds. Investigators recovered a gun in the home. The San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office will perform autopsies to determine the cause and manner of death for all three victims.

At this time, the names of the three deceased victims are being withheld pending notification of their next of kin.
