PARKS AND RECREATION STAFF REPORT:

Area Manager Report: Oscar Eusebio

We did pass our reclaimed water inspection. We passed two years in a row. Each year it is more challenging. We have three ground maintenance workers. The toilet paper rolls are on hold. I will pass this responsibility to Javon. We got a new recreation aide. Her name is Serenity.

There are no park closures as stated in earlier reports. We would like to thank the City Council Reps for advocating for us. We are not out of the woods. The other part is that they are looking at a reduction of hours. If you know of anyone – the community can speak out.

We have two new people working here - Avani Husges - Center Direction III. Javon Martin is the Assistant Center Director.

For the movies in the park – we emailed the vendors that rent from us. Netflix is going to be there.

For the partition wall – Javon is looking at companies that will fix it. Javon will send the quotes to Oscar when I get them.

There was an uneven sidewalk and we got it sanded so now it is fixed.

The ceiling was leaking and it flooded the last time it rained. We had the roofers come out. The roofers said that the problems is the pipes above the ceiling tiles under the roof. Another pipe has shifted. So it is a plumbing problem.

The blue wiggle ladder at the kids' park is loose. I think Nicole put in a purchase order, but I have to check with her. Until it is fixed, Oscar suggested that they board it up so no one gets hurt.

The dog park – one of the gates is messed up. Javon put in a request for that.

There is recent graffiti around here. One of the City volunteers - David - plays ping pong here. He tells us where it is. He has all the supplies and he volunteers to remove the graffiti. He sends us pictures before and after.

Large RV was parked near the dog park. Javon talked to him and he left. Linda suggested that we make a flyer of places that are available for them to park.

We have irrigation around the park where things are leaking. One of the pipes might have broken. That is going to be taken care of. We are walking the park to check for leaks.

One of our staff, Lawrence, his art class is going well. The class is on Wednesday morning.

Our other staff, Lisa, has 10 children (under five years old) signed up for pee wee echo art class. Tuesday mornings.

She also has a pee wee sports class. Serenity helps with play golf. They have volunteers teach golf. PGA ranked professionals teach it. There are 19 kids signed up for it.
