

TO THE COMMON COUNCIL OF SAN DIEGO.

Gentlemen:-

We hereby charge Chas. Twombly of <sup>A</sup>Red, White, and Blue saloon at <sup>s</sup>east corner of 3d. and I streets, with violating Sec. eleven of ordinance No. 1541, of the ordinances of the city of San Diego, California, in the following instances:

Specification 1. That May 11, between the hours of 9, P.M. and midnight the said Chas. Twombly did harbor and permit to remain in his saloon three women, some of whom were known lewd and dissolute females and common prostitutes.

Specification 2. That May 14, between the hours of eleven P.M. and midnight the said Twombly did harbor and permit to remain in his saloon four women, some of whom were known dissolute and lewd females and common prostitutes.

Specification 3. That May 17, between the hours of 11: P.M. and midnight, the said Twombly did allow and permit to remain in his saloon three women, some of whom were lewd and dissolute females and common prostitutes. They were heard to use indecent and vulgar language.

Specification 4. That May 19, between the hours of 9 and eleven P.M. the said Twombly did allow and permit four women to remain in his saloon some of whom were known to be lewd and dissolute and common prostitutes.

Specification 5. That May 21, between the hours of 8:30 P.M. and midnight the said Twombly did harbor and permit to remain in his saloon five women, some of whom were known to be lewd and dissolute females and common prostitutes.
