 Residential Blue Curb Fee (Duncan Hughes, Deputy Director, Transportation Department)
Mr. Hughes reviewed the history and upcoming recommend change to the blue curb fee. The increase in fee is due to recent City employee salary increases, as the fee is designed to be 100% cost recoverable. The recommend amount is increasing from \$277 to \$355.
