NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

PROJECT NAME/NUMBER: Special Event Permit – Vegan Food Popup

COMMUNITY PLAN AREA: North Park

COUNCIL DISTRICT: 3

LOCATION: North Park Mini Park, North Park Way between 29th St. and Granada Ave. (see attached

map)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Special Event Permit for a monthly, year-round market that would occur at North Park Mini Park, on North Park Way between 29th St. and Granada Ave. every second Saturday in 2023 from January 14, 2023 to December 9, 2023. The event would include food vendors, food trucks, food preparation, merchandise vendors, wellness services, performances/entertainment, sound amplification, tents/canopies, tables, portable restroom, recycling, and trash containers. For each second Saturday in 2023, noise associated with the event activities and set-up/ dismantling would occur from 11 AM to 5 PM. Set-up would occur from 11 AM until 12 PM, the market would occur from 12 PM until 4 PM, and clean-up/dismantling would occur from 4 PM to 5 PM.

A road closure associated with the event would include North Park Way between 29th Street and Granada Ave. (see attached map) and from 9 AM to 5:30 PM.

A parking closure associated with the event would include six parking spaces on the west curb of 29th St. north of North Park Way between the middle of 29th Street and North Park Way. and from 9 AM to 5:30 PM.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section(s): Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) which allows for the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing or minor alterations of existing public or private structures or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use; Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land) which allows for minor, temporary use

of land that has negligible or no permanent effects on the environment; Section 15311 (Accessory Structures) which allows for construction, or placement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial, or institutional facilities, including, but not limited to, temporary use items in publicly owned facilities or other facilities designated for public use; and where the exceptions listed in CEQA Guidelines Section 15300.2 would not apply in that no cumulative impacts were identified; no significant effects on the environment were identified; the project is not adjacent to a scenic highway; no historical resources would be affected by the action; and the project was not identified on a list of hazardous waste sites pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code.

Applications to appeal CEQA determination to the City Council must be filed with the Office of the Clerk within 5 business days from the date of the posting of this Notice (**December 21, 2022**). During the Statewide "Safer-at-Home" directive to reduce the spread of COVID-19, beginning March 19, 2021, appeals to the City Clerk must be filed by email or US Mail as follows:

- 1. Appeals filed via E-mail: Send the appeal by email to Hearings1@sandiego.gov; your email appeal will be acknowledged within 24 hours. The appeal application can be obtained here. You must separately mail the appeal fee by check payable to the City Treasurer to: City Clerk/Appeal, MS 2A, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101. The appeal filing fee must be postmarked within 5 business days of the date the appeal is filed.
- 2. <u>Appeals filed In-Person:</u> The appeal application can be obtained in the Lobby of the City Administration Building located at 202 'C' Street, San Diego, CA 92101. The completed appeal package must include the required appeal fee in the form of a check payable to the City Treasurer to: City Clerk/Appeal, MS 2A, 202 C Street, San Diego, CA 92101.


