Updates from February's Meeting

- A. Martinez General Housing Bills Update:
 - o 2,800 bills were introduced this year in the California legislature. Last Friday was the deadline for submittal to the Assembly; Senate will be next Friday.
 - O Assembly and Senate had a joint legislative hearing on housing. One take away is that they have made it easier and cheaper to build ADUs, and it's working. There has been a huge increase in the number of permits issued over the past few years for ADUs.

Discussion and Action Item on SB 10

- H. Wayne gave an overview of the bill. It is not ministerial. The timeline expires January 2029.
- West of I-5 is a 30' height limit. This allows the government to be exempt from CEQA.
- There is no reference in SB 10 that the added density be affordable.
- Motion by H. Wayne to recommend to the Linda Vista Planning Group that it adopts a letter urging City Council to implement SB 10 with the following conditions:
 - o Add 15% affordable housing and 15% missing middle housing be built
 - o Funds raised through development impact fees generated by densification *stay* in the community
- Motion passed unanimously

Surplus Land Act

 H. Wayne gave an overview of the efforts taken to submit language to Assemblymember Chris Ward's Office about modifying SLA to support community land trusts. The proposal should be



flushed out in 2023 with the Community Land Trust Network in an effort to get the language included in the 2024 legislative cycle for FY25.
